Blue Point Fire Department offers two graduating seniors (male and female) each a \$1,000 scholarship. The criteria to be selected is as follows:

1. The student must be a candidate for graduation.
2. Involvement in school activities.
3. Involvement in community service-related activities.
4. Academic standing - top 50% of class.

If you wish to be considered for this scholarship, please submit your resume and essay in accordance with the established criteria.

Please submit your "essay of application" to the Guidance Office no later than April 1, 2019.

SCHOLARSHIP SELECTION

Final selection of the scholarship winner will be made in two phases:

1. Each student will be requested to prepare an essay no longer than 500 words on the following topic:

As a volunteer organization, the members of the Blue Point Fire Department pride themselves on giving back to the community. Please describe how civic involvement has shaped you. What does civic involvement mean to you and how you will you embrace this in your daily life?

Additionally, each student will submit a resume to include grades and class standing, special courses, club and sports involvement, and community service /volunteer activities. Include anything you think might help the committee to better understand who you are and why you are deserving of this award. ***A resume form is attached.***

2. The Blue Point Fire Department Scholarship Committee will evaluate:
 - The student's written essay and resume.
 - The student's involvement in school/community activities.

When the selection is made, the school district will be formally notified so that the appropriate arrangements can be made for presentation at Senior Awards Night.
